# Course Description

What is a Human Resource (HR) Strategy? A Human Resource strategy is a business's overall plan for managing its human capital to align it with its business activities and objectives. The Human Resource strategy sets the direction for all the key areas of HR including Talent Acquisition, Talent Development, Succession Planning, Reward & Recognition and Organizational Development. The Human Resource strategy is a long-term plan that dictates HR policies, processes, practices & systems throughout the organization.

Why is Human Resource (HR) Strategy important? The HR Strategy ensures closer alignment between HR & an organization's overall business strategy. Hence it provides a competitive advantage to the organization by creating the capability to proactively anticipate & respond to customer needs and needs of the other stakeholders.

Human Resource Strategy helps to direct the behaviour and actions of all employees towards fulfilling end goals & objectives of the organization. An effective HR Strategy creates differentiating culture for attracting, developing and retaining the best talent and fuels the growth of the organization.

- **Activity:** Talent Gap Analysis Workshop – hands-on activity to identify and plan for talent gaps
- **Game:** Workforce Planning Challenge – teams compete to create the most effective workforce plan
- **Case Study:** Review and discussion of a company's strategic workforce planning approach

- **Activity:** Designing a Training Program – hands-on activity to create an L&D program for a specific need
- **Game:** L&D Investment Game – prioritize and allocate resources to various L&D initiatives
- **Case Study:** Evaluating the L&D strategy of a successful organization

### **Session 3: Performance Management Systems**

- **Activity:** Creating Performance Objectives – workshop on setting effective performance goals and KPIs
- **Game:** Performance Appraisal Role-Play – practice conducting performance reviews
- **Case Study:** Case study on a company that transformed its performance management system

## **Day 3: Implementation of HR Strategies**

### **Session 1: Change Management in HR**

- **Activity:** Change Management Planning – participants develop a change management plan for an HR initiative
- **Game:** Change Management Simulation – interactive game to manage change in a fictional company
- **Case Study:** Success and failure stories of HR change initiatives

### **Session 2: HR Technology and Systems**

- **Activity:** Exploring HRIS – hands-on session with HRIS software demos
- **Game:** HR Tech Challenge – teams solve HR problems using technology solutions
- **Case Study:** Case study on how a company successfully implemented HR technology

### **Session 3: HR Policies and Compliance**

- **Activity:** Policy Development Workshop – participants draft or revise an HR policy
- **Game:** Compliance Scenarios – role-play scenarios to navigate legal and compliance challenges
- **Case Study:** Review of a company's approach to maintaining compliance and managing employee relations

## **Day 4: Monitoring and Evaluating HR Strategies**

### **Session 1: Metrics and Analytics in HR**

- **Activity:** Creating HR Dashboards – workshop on designing dashboards for HR metrics
- **Game:** HR Analytics Puzzle – teams analyze data to solve HR issues
- **Case Study:** Analysis of a company that effectively uses HR analytics

### **Session 2: Continuous Improvement in HR**

- **Activity:** Benchmarking Exercise – participants compare their HR practices with industry standards
- **Game:** Improvement Strategy Game – identify and implement continuous improvement strategies
- **Case Study:** Examination of a company's journey towards continuous HR improvement

### **Session 3: Case Studies and Best Practices**

- **Activity:** Group Discussion – sharing best practices and lessons learned
- **Game:** Case Study Competition – teams present solutions to a given HR challenge
- **Case Study:** Multiple case studies review and discussion on best practices in HR strategy
